

CITY COUNCIL

May 18, 2009

The May 18, 2009 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Gary Veith, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Paul Wagner, Mike Kuenzli, Bud Miller, Chad Smith, Scot Swinehart, and Gary Veith. Evie Hall-Case was absent.

Others present included: Mark Ellis, Law Director; Sam Molnar; Alissa Paoella, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Molnar, Clerk.

The minutes of the May 4, 2009 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the May 5, 2009 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the May 11, 2009 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the May 12, 2009 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the May 14, 2009 Planning Commission meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

It was noted that a tour of the City's Safety and Service facilities is being planned and City Council members will be notified as to the date and time of this tour.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Smith, to place Ordinance No. 217-11 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 37-10 AND 182-11 AND AMENDING SECTION 131.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO ADDRESSING THE CRITERIA FOR AN ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT TO THE UPPER SANDUSKY POLICE DEPARTMENT.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 217-11 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to place Ordinance No. 218-11 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 205-11, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2009, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried.

Mr. Veith reported that Mr. Kenneth McMillan, Zoning Inspector, is pursuing properties in need of mowing, pursuant to the City's weed cutting requirements.

Mr. Veith also noted that residents should not blow their grass clippings into the street as these clippings get into the City's storm sewer and create water back up problems.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
