

CITY COUNCIL  
MAY 17<sup>TH</sup>, 2010

The May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Mr. Gary Veith, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Mr. Gary Veith, Mr. Paul Wagner, Mr. Kyle McColly, Mr. Chad Smith, Mr. Don Spiegel, and Mr. Scot Swinehart. Mrs. Evie Hall-Case was absent.

Others present included: Mark Ellis, Law Director; John Hawkins; Chanda Neely, Daily Chief Union; and Linda K. Stansbery, Administrative Assistant.

The minutes of the May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2010 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2010 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

The Service Committee extended an invitation to City Council for a tour to view the progress on the new water plant. The tour will follow the June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Service Committee meeting.

The minutes of the May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2010 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

Discussion was held concerning the purchase of flowers for the downtown area.

The minutes of the May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Special Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Planning Commission meeting, having been mailed to each member, were reviewed.

Discussion was held concerning a letter received from Columbia Gas. It was noted that Columbia Gas will be replacing 850 risers throughout the City.

Discussion was held concerning a letter from the Wyandot County Extension Office which stated they would not support an atrazine lawsuit.

A motion was made by Mr. Veith, seconded by Mr. Smith, to take Ordinance No. 24-10 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 133.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO ADDRESSING THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A FULL-TIME FIREFIGHTER TO THE UPPER SANDUSKY FIRE DEPARTMENT, AS AMENDED AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", off the table. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Veith, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to place Ordinance No. 24-10 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 133.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO ADDRESSING THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A FULL-TIME FIREFIGHTER TO THE UPPER SANDUSKY FIRE DEPARTMENT, AS AMENDED AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading, by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Acting Clerk read Ordinance No. 24-12 for the second time, by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 24-10. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Smith, to place Resolution No. 25-12 entitled, "A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE ADOPTED DRAFT WYANDOT COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR SUBMISSION TO THE DIRECTOR OF OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR HIS REVIEW AND APPROVAL.", on its first reading, by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried. The Acting Clerk read Resolution No. 25-12 for the first time, by title only.

City Council reminded citizens that grass should not be blown into the street as this will block the storm sewers.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
