

CITY COUNCIL

May 25, 2011

The May 25, 2011 special City Council meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Gary Veith, Chairman. City Council members present were Evie Hall-Case, Kyle McColly, Don Spiegel, Scot Swinehart, and Gary Veith. Chad Smith and Paul Wagner were absent.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Allen Boes, Street and Sanitation Supervisor; Chanda Neely, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The purpose of this meeting was to review information and vote on legislation for the resurfacing of a portion of State Route 53 and a portion of State Route 199 located within the City.

A motion was made by Mr. Veith, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to place Ordinance No. 62-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, WYANDOT COUNTY, OHIO, IN THE MATTER OF THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED IMPROVEMENT AND TO REQUEST THE COOPERATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 62-12 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Veith, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to suspend the rules of the Municipal Charter calling for separate readings on different days. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mrs. Hall-Case, to place Ordinance No. 62-12 on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 62-12 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 62-12. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 62-12 was duly adopted.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
