

CITY COUNCIL

January 3, 2012

The January 3, 2012 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of the United States of America. City Council members present were Kyle McColly, Rick Roberts, Chad Smith, Don Spiegel, Scot Swinehart, Bill Thornton, and Evie Hall-Case.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Jon Hawkins; Chanda Neely, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the December 19, 2012 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the December 19, 2012 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

City Council members reviewed the Income Tax Collections and Transient Guest Tax Collections reports as of December 30, 2011.

It was also noted that the Annual Report for 2011 was also received from Mr. Mark Ellis, Law Director.

City Council members received an application for an upcoming Tree Commission Academy for anyone interested in attending.

The appointment of the Charter Review Commission was discussed. Mr. Spiegel requested each City Council members submit the name of an individual to serve on the Commission at the next City Council meeting. It was noted that the individuals selected to serve on the Charter Review Commission must reside within the City and be qualified electors (registered voters).

It was decided that the next City Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 17, 2012 due to the Martin Luther King Day holiday.

Mayor Washburn presented the following list of individuals to be appointed/reappointed to standing committees: John Booth – Park Board (5 year term); Jack Leonard – Park Board (1 year term); Jordan Treadway - Planning Commission (4 year term); John Walker – Tree Commission (3 year term); Bob Blocksom – Board of Zoning Appeals (4 year term); and Lorena Walton – Board of Zoning Appeals (4 year term).

A motion was made by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to approve the Mayor's list of appointments/reappointments to the standing committees as presented. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.
