

CITY COUNCIL

October 15, 2012

The October 15, 2012 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Bill Thornton, Evie Hall-Case, Kyle McColly, Rick Roberts, Chad Smith, and Don Spiegel. Scot Swinehart was absent.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Bob Steiert; Cathy Browne, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the October 1, 2012 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

It was noted that Mrs. Regina Brinson, Water Office employee, retired today after thirty-seven (37) years of service to the City. City Council members and Mayor Washburn expressed their appreciation to Mrs. Brinson for her years of service to the City.

Mayor Washburn reported that Mr. Dave Dlubak, owner of Ithaca Guns, was nationally recognized recently as he presented a specially made Romney-Ryan Ithaca shotgun to Paul Ryan, U.S. Vice Presidential nominee. Although Mr. Ryan could not accept the gun, he signed it and it will be auctioned off at the U.S. Sportsmen's Alliance annual banquet in Columbus.

Mayor Washburn indicated that the Midget League Pumpkin Bowl will be held on Saturday, October 20, 2012.

Mayor Washburn reported that job descriptions for all City positions have been completed, and either each subcommittee has to review and sign off or the Mayor can be designated to review and sign off on behalf of the subcommittees.
