

CITY COUNCIL

August 18, 2014

The August 18, 2014 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Tom Shumaker, Don Spiegel, Bill Thornton, Bob Blocksom, Roxie Karg, and Rick Roberts. Scot Swinehart was absent.

The minutes of August 4, 2014 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, to place Ordinance No. 174-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE, ADOPT AND ENACT THE 2014 REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES: TO REPEAL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH: TO PUBLISH THE ENACTMENT OF NEW MATTER: AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 174-12 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Blocksom, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 174-12. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 174-12 was duly adopted.

Due to the upcoming Labor Day Holiday, the next City Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 2, 2014 along with the Safety Committee, Service Committee, and Planning Commission meetings.

Ms. Karg indicated that Highland Parkway has been resurfaced and that improvement will be greatly appreciated by the residents of that area. It was also noted that the City has also addressed roadway improvements on South Warpole Street.

It was noted that the Service Committee has decided that fall clean-up within the City will be held September 22 thru September 26, 2014.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
