

CITY COUNCIL

February 16, 2015

The February 16, 2015 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Rick Roberts, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Roxie Karg, Rick Roberts, Tom Shumaker, Don Spiegel, Scot Swinehart, Bill Thornton, and Bob Blocksom.

The President declared the motion carried by a 6-0-1 vote and Ordinance No. 191-12 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to place Ordinance No. 193-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WYANDOT COUNTY FOR THE APPLICATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE PY 2015 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION PROGRAM.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members

voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 193-12 for the first time by title only.

Mayor Washburn indicated that the Street Department employees along the employees from the Water Treatment Plant, Wastewater Treatment Plant, and Parks Department are doing a nice job removing snow from the streets and sidewalks. It was also noted that the Street Department is patching streets as needed.

A list of streets being considered for repaving by the Service Committee was reviewed by City Council. This project will be bid in the near future.

It was noted that the Service Committee hired Mr. Andrew Wiegand for the vacancy in the Sanitation Department.

Mayor Washburn reported that the City's phone number is listed wrong in a phone book that was recently distributed.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
