

CITY COUNCIL

October 19, 2015

The October 19, 2015 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Rick Roberts, Chairman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Tom Shumaker, Don Spiegel, Scot Swinehart, Bill Thornton, Bob Blocksom, and Rick Roberts. Roxie Karg was absent.

Others present included: Mark Ellis, Law Director; Mark Droll, City Auditor; Dale Hartle, Ohio Regional Development Corporation; Alissa Paoella, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the October 5, 2015 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the October 1, 2015 Board of Zoning Appeals hearings, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the October 5, 2015 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the October 5, 2015 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the October 13, 2015 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

Mr. Dale Hartle, Ohio Regional Development Corporation, addressed City Council concerning the City's Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program (CHIP). Mr. Hartle explained the rules and regulations of fair housing and presented an overview of the City's FY 13 CHIP which ends on October 31, 2015. Mr. Hartle stated that the City and the County were recently awarded \$800,000.00 for owner rehab and home repair projects with this project to take fifteen to eighteen months to complete.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Ordinance No. 212-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 184-12, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2015, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 212-12 for the first time by title only.

Mr. Droll reviewed the recapitulation for September 2015 with the members of City Council.
