

CITY COUNCIL

June 6, 2016

The June 6, 2016 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Tom Shumaker, Don Spiegel, Bill Thornton, Bob Blocksom, Roxie Karg, and Rick Roberts. Scot Swinehart was absent.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Mark Droll, City Auditor; Laurie Vent, Upper Sandusky Schools Superintendent; Alissa Paoletta, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the May 16, 2016 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the May 16, 2016 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the May 23, 2016 special Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Ordinance No. 229-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2016 DODGE RAM 2500 PICK-UP TRUCK THROUGH THE STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 229-12 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Shumaker, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 229-12. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 229-12 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Blocksom, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Ordinance No. 230-12 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 216-12, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 230-12 for the first time by title only.

It was reported that the summer help workers are currently painting the light poles located in the downtown area gloss black.

Mr. Ellis indicated that revised draft copies of the Yard Maintenance Ordinance were distributed to the members of City Council. This legislation will be presented at the June 20, 2016 City Council meeting for its first reading.

City Council members reviewed the Recapitulation for April 2016.

Mayor Washburn reported that road pavement grinding began today under the City's Street Program. Road paving is expected to begin tomorrow with the project to possibly be completed later this week. Mayor Washburn indicated that he will also be meeting with Mr. Gary Huffman soon to discuss additional paving projects within the City.

It was noted that the Relay for Life event will take place this weekend at the Upper Sandusky High School Athletic Complex, beginning at 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Saturday.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
