November 6, 2017

The November 6, 2017 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Mays, to place Ordinance No. 22-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 243-12, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2017, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 22-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 22-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 22-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Ms. Karg, to place Ordinance No. 24-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 191.03, 191.062 (D) (1), 191.063(B) (4) and (5), 191.07(C) (1) (d), and 191.10 (C) (3), AND ADDING SECTIONS 191.063 (B) (4), 191.063 (B) (5), AND 191.80 THROUGH 191.95 TO CHAPTER 191 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY REGARDING MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 24-13 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Mays, to place Ordinance No. 25-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 191.013 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 25-13 for the first time by title only.

Mr. Droll reviewed the Recapitulation for October 2017 with the members of City Council.

Mr. Thornton indicated that he received positive feedback regarding all of the Halloween activities that took place recently.

It was noted that there is a possibility that the Fire Department's aerial fire truck could possibly be delivered in late November or early December.

It was also noted that tomorrow is Election Day.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
