

CITY COUNCIL

January 16, 2018

The January 16, 2018 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, Marc Mays, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, and Bill Thornton.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the January 2, 2018 Organizational City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Korte, to place Ordinance No. 31-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE WYANDOT COUNTY NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 31-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Mays, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 31-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 31-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Ordinance No. 32-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE THREE YEAR LEASE OF TWO 2018 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR SPORT UTILITY VEHICLES WITH EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE STATE PURCHASING PROGRAM.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted as follows:

Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 33-13 for the first time by title only.

Mr. Thornton stated that he has received compliments on the leaf pick-up that was done by the Street Department.

Mr. Spiegel indicated that the Street Department has done an excellent job on snow removal this winter.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
