

## CITY COUNCIL

April 2, 2018

The April 2, 2018 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Mays, to place Resolution No. 35-13 entitled, "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF A COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP A STRATEGY TO PROTECT THE WATER SOURCES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Resolution No. 35-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, for the adoption of Resolution No. 35-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Resolution No. 35-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, to place Ordinance No. 36-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, OHIO TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN FUND AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY FOR PLANNING, DESIGN AND/OR CONSTRUCTION OF WASTEWATER FACILITIES AND DESIGNATING A DEDICATED REPAYMENT SOURCE FOR THE LOAN, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 36-13 for the first time by title only.

Mayor Washburn indicated that the Street Department is still planning to repair potholes within the City as soon as the weather permits.
