

CITY COUNCIL

May 7, 2018

The May 7, 2018 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, Marc Mays, Don Spiegel, and Bill Thornton. Rick Roberts was absent.

Others present included: Scott Wasburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Michael Thoma, Southeastern Equipment; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the April 16, 2018 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the April 16, 2018 Tree Commission meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the April 16, 2018 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the April 23, 2018 Board of Zoning Appeals hearing, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Mays, to place Ordinance No. 37-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2019 FREIGHTLINER CHASSIS AND NEW WAY GARBAGE PACKER BODY PLUS ACCESSORIES AND WARRANTIES THROUGH THE FEDERAL PURCHASING PROGRAM.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 37-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Walker, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 37-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 37-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Walker, seconded by Mr. Korte, to place Ordinance No. 38-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 28-13, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2018, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 38-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Thornton, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 38-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 38-13 was duly adopted.

It was reported that Spring Clean-Up went well with approximately one hundred (100) tons of garbage collected during that week. During normal weekly trash pick-up approximately thirty-five (35) to forty (40) tons of garbage is collected.

It was noted that the Tree City USA Awards Program held Wednesday, April 18, 2018 and the Arbor Day Program held Monday, April 30, 2018 went well.

It was also noted that the Police Department's Ford Police Interceptor sport utility vehicles should be in service soon.

Mr. Walker inquired as to what streets will be repaved/resurfaced this year. Mayor Washburn indicated that a final decision has not been made on this matter yet, but South Warpole Street, between Wyandot Avenue and Spring Street, will definitely be addressed this year.

Mr. Walker reported on a complaint received a couple weeks ago of trash blowing out of a roll-off dumpster located in River's Edge Subdivision. Mayor Washburn stated that the City or the developer should have been contacted when this issue occurred. Mayor Washburn also noted that the City does not own any roll-off dumpsters.

The Safety Committee has schedule Trick-or-Treat to take place on Saturday, October 27, 2018 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
