A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Booth, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$3,176.00. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the July 13, 2009 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each Park Board member, were approved as received.

Mrs. Pat Karg, Pool Manager, addressed the Park Board and indicated that the final day of the 2009 swimming pool season will be Tuesday, August 18, 2009. Mrs. Karg also apologized to the Park Board for recent incidents at the pool that she did not realize were not allowable practices. It was noted that Monday, August 17, 2009 will be a day of free admission to the pool and the Salvation Army will be holding an event in the park to be held in conjunction with the free admission. Mrs. Karg also noted that the Wyandot County Youth Commission's annual Sync or Swim event held in Harrison Smith Park on Friday, August 7, 2009 went well, however there were not many swimmers at the pool as part of the event.

A request was presented from Mr. William Webster to sell raffle tickets at a concert to be held at the bandshell in Harrison Smith Park on Saturday, August 22, 2009, with the proceeds to benefit research for chromosome disorders. Park Board members voiced no objections to this request.

It was noted that the City's town hall meeting was held at the bandshell on Thursday, August 6, 2009.

Mr. Wessler reported that the shelter being donated by the Rotary to be located at the reservoir will be completed soon. Mayor Washburn indicated that a suggestion was received to place a charcoal grill near this shelter.

Mrs. Freehling reported a complaint received concerning cheerleader tryouts being held at Bicentennial Park while a family picnic was taking place. It was noted that the City was unaware that these tryouts were being held in the park.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
