A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Wagner, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$13,521.54. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the May 9, 2011 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each Park Board member, were approved as received.

Park Board members recognized Boy Scout Colin Marshall who was in attendance to earn a merit badge.

It was noted that the first day of school for Upper Sandusky Schools is Monday, August 22, 2011. The date set for the final day of the 2011 swimming pool season is Sunday, August 21, 2011.

Mr. Moore reported that the new tractor received seven days ago has been in an accident. Approximately \$1,700.00 in damage was incurred. Parts to repair the tractor have been ordered.

Mayor Washburn reported on a request received from Mr. Jack Oehlers, 517 West Johnson Street, for the City to place a fence adjacent to his property as his property is being damaged by people coming onto his property from the adjacent Water Tower softball field. Park Board members agreed to look at the situation and asked the Mayor to ask the softball league to ask people to stay off Mr. Oehler's property.

It was noted that the section of bicycle/walking path that was damaged due to a water line being bored underneath the path for the new water plant. This area of the path will be repaired.

Mayor Washburn reported that he requested Mr. Moore to obtain a quote for the resurfacing of the basketball court in Harrison Smith Park as this court is in serious need of resurfacing. Randy indicated that the quote received to resurface the basketball court is \$2,500.00. Mr. Wessler suggested the Lions Club or the Rotary Club be contacted to determine if they would be interested in this project.

Ms. Sarah Bennett reported that some of the equipment at the swimming pool that is worn out has been replaced.

Ms. Bennett also reported that Lifeguards Scott Warfel and Ashleigh Kline have both separately had to pull children from the swimming pool during potentially life threatening situations.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
