A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Wentling, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$11,869.84. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the May 4, 2015 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each Park Board member, were approved as received.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Leonard, to enter into an executive session to discuss personnel. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried. Upon completion of the executive session, the Park Board reconvened into regular session.

Mr. Randy Moore recommended the Park Board hire Mr. Kyle Bradley as a full-time Park Department employee.

A motion was made by Mr. Leonard, seconded by Mr. Blackburn, to hire Mr. Kyle Bradley as a full-time Park Department employee at an hourly rate of \$12.00 per hour, effective immediately. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Moore reported that the fountain at Stepping Stones Park has been replaced.

Mr. Moore also reported on repeated vandalism at the skate bowl in Bicentennial Park and indicated that he would like to order a game camera to be placed in Bicentennial Park.

Mr. Wentling indicated that he has received complaints of dogs being permitted to run off leash in Stepping Stones Park and someone driving their golf cart thru Stepping Stones Park in the evening.

Mr. Blackburn noted that the bottom step on the bleachers at the Bandshell in Harrison Smith Park is loose.

It was noted that the Farmers Market continues to be held in Harrison Smith Park and no problems have been experienced.

It was also noted that the softball leagues played at Harrison Smith Park are currently in season.

It was reported that people have been observed fishing at the ponds in Harrison Smith Park and Duck Pond Park who do not meet the age restriction requirements.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
