Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Keith Niederkohr, Parks Manager, informed the Park Board members that many of the streets have been paved for the Sewer Separation Project, which will alleviate a lot of the traffic issues for the Winter Fantasy of Lights.

Mr. Niederkohr also reported that donations from the Co-Ed Softball League, Trinity Youth Group, Young Professionals Group, Rotary, Westbrook Inn and Fairhaven were received for the new fencing around Rotary Field Diamond.

Park Board members expressed their appreciation to Mr. Brian Gottfried for his knowledge and assistance in the re-crowning and conditioning of the baseball diamonds at the Park.

Mayor Washburn and Park Board members expressed their appreciation to Mr. Niederkohr on a job well done in his new role as Park Manager.
