The minutes of the September 11, 2017 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each Park Board member, were approved as received.

Mr. Niederkoeh reported on the following:

- Trailers for the Winter Fantasy of Lights will be unloaded in Harrison Smith Park on Saturday, October 28, 2017.
- The roadways in Harrison Smith Park will be closed on November 1, 2017. Visitors to the park will be able to park their vehicles near the pool house and walk in the park.
- The Bandshell project has been completed.
- Concrete for a sidewalk was poured in Harrison Smith Park near the white shelter to connect the driveway to the door. This was done for the Winter Fantasy of Lights.
- Concrete for a sidewalk was poured in Bicentennial Park connecting the new parking lot to the basketball courts which was formerly the in-line skating rink.

Mr. Blackburn reported that he was contacted recently by Ms. Karen Humphrey regarding the Home for the Holidays 5K Run to take place on Saturday, December 9, 2017. Ms. Humphrey inquired as to if the Winter Fantasy of Lights Committee had any objections to the run taking place in Harrison Smith Park, as the park will be set up for the Winter Fantasy of Lights at that time. Mr. Blackburn indicated that the Winter Fantasy of Lights Committee voiced no objections.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
