Park Board members reviewed revised wording, composed by Mr. Korte, for the plaque to be placed in Bicentennial Park in memory of Robby Lee. Mr. Korte indicated that this information has been presented to Mrs. Sharon Lee and she has approved.

It was reported that due to the low number of applications received for lifeguards for the 2018 swimming pool season, the help wanted advertisement will be placed in the newspaper again.

Discussion was held regarding the hiring of a pool manager for the 2018 swimming pool season.

A motion was made by Mr. Huffman, seconded by Mr. Leonard, to hire Miss Catie Richman as the pool manager for the 2018 swimming pool season. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Niederkoehr reported that the softball leagues are scheduled to begin playing games tomorrow.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
