A motion was made by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$37,524.20. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the June 2, 2009 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the June 26, 2009 special Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Chief Sturgeon was asked if the leaf springs on the Fire Department's brush buggy have been replaced, as approved by the Safety Committee at the June 2, 2009 meeting. Chief Sturgeon indicated that prices are currently being acquired for this repair.

Chief Sturgeon presented four lease options from Fire Safety Services for the self-contained breathing apparatuses. It was noted that a price break is offered at a minimum of ten units. The lease information will be copied and distributed to the members of the Safety Committee for their consideration.

Safety Committee members reviewed a liquor permit transfer from Tierra Blanca LLC (DBA Los Arcos) to La Presa LLC (DBA Los Arcos). The Safety Committee voiced no objections to the transfer of this liquor permit.

Safety Committee members reviewed a request to replace a second handicap parking space and move two signs designating two hour parking spaces located along the west side of North Fifth Street at the intersection of East Wyandot Avenue and adjacent to Dr. Arnold's office. It was noted that the first handicapped parking space was widened recently due to new regulations and the second handicapped parking space was eliminated and the existing two hour parking signs were not moved to the north and do not line up with the existing parking spaces.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Smith to approve the replacement of the second handicap parking space and to have the two signs designating two hour parking moved further to the north along the west side of North Fifth Street adjacent to Dr. Arnold's office. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried.

Captain Heil indicated that Section 537.12 Misuse of 9-1-1 System of the City's Codified Ordinances, as taken from the Ohio Revised Code Section 4931.40, is missing a subsection. Captain Heil requested this section be included in the City's Codified Ordinances. The Walter H. Drane Company will be contacted concerning this matter.

Mayor Washburn expressed appreciation to Police Lieutenant Allen Foust as he purchased coffee while on duty for Water Department employees who were called in and spent many hours repairing a water leak on July 3, 2009.

Chief Sturgeon reported that the Fire Department's annual chicken barbeque and the City's fireworks display went well on Saturday, July 4, 2009.

Chief Sturgeon also reported that the Fire Department also responded to a call for mutual aid this afternoon from the Carey Fire Department.

Chief Sturgeon expressed appreciation on behalf of the Fire Department for the fire hydrants throughout the City being painted with colors to identify the amount of water flow.

A motion was made by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Swinehart, to enter into an executive session to discuss a personnel matter. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried. Upon completion of the executive session, the Safety Committee reconvened into regular session.

There being no further business, the Acting Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
