A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Thornton, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$18,455.04. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the May 5, 2014 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Safety Committee members again reviewed the request to eliminate parking on one side of the streets in Rivers Edge Subdivision as previously presented and discussed by the Safety Committee. Safety Committee members agreed to table this request and continue to monitor the situation.

Mayor Washburn presented an estimate of \$4,575.00 from Niederkohr Construction to repair the seams of the duralast roof on the Safety Building.

A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to accept the estimate of \$4,575.00 from Niederkohr Construction to repair the seams of the duralast roof on the Safety

Building. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Thornton presented a concern about pedestrians walking along State Route 53 to and from the subdivision located to the north of the fairgrounds. It was noted that both sides of the roadway in this area are not in the City limits. This matter will be referred to the Sheriff's Department and the County Commissioners.

Chief Olds reported the following:

- Parking citations have been printed and will be issued as needed under the new guidelines established and adopted by City Council.
- Delivery of one of the new police cruisers is expected any day.

Chief Yeater reported the following:

- The projected delivery date of the new fire truck approved for purchase by City Council is June 30, 2014.
- Pump testing for the fire trucks was completed and all trucks passed this testing.
- Ground ladder testing is upcoming.
- The Fire Department's annual Chicken Barbeque will be held on Friday, July 4, 2014.

Mayor Washburn reported on an email received from a lady complimenting Lieutenant Dan Ross for assistance he provided as her car had broken down.

Mr. Roberts reported that he recently saw a small child crossing the street unattended and he contacted the Police Department and Officer Jared Lucas responded and did a good job handling the situation.

It was noted that the Chamber of Commerce's annual fireworks display is scheduled to be held at the high school on Thursday, July 3, 2014.

There being no further business, the Acting Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
