A motion was made by Mr. Swinehart, seconded by Mr. Thornton, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$49,300.66. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes from the April 7, 2014 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Safety Committee members reviewed a notice received from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control for a new liquor license for Elaine Boes Thomson (dba Violas) to be located at 119 North Sandusky Avenue. Safety Committee members voiced no objections to this request.

Safety Committee members also reviewed a request from Mr. Eric Yeater, 214 South Fourth Street, for the placement of two "Children at Play" signs to both be located along the north side of each end of the east/west alley in the 200 block between South Fourth Street and South Fifth Street. The Safety Committee denied this request.

A request referred by the Service Committee was reviewed to eliminate parking on one side of the streets in Rivers Edge Subdivision as problems exist for vehicles traveling on the streets when cars are parked on both sides because it narrows the roadway for traffic and makes it difficult to travel down the center of the road. Safety Committee members tabled this request until they have the opportunity to view the area and obtain additional information.

Chief Yeater reported that seventeen (17) of the Fire Department's air packs have been flow tested and some repairs have been made. Hose testing and pump testing are scheduled for the near future. Quotes will be obtained for ground ladder testing.

Captain Heil reported that the Police Department is still waiting on the delivery of the new police cruisers.

Captain Heil also reported that Officer Tyler Howell and Officer James Kee will be attending upcoming schooling, and Officer Andrew Silcox and canine Officer Hunter will be attending upcoming schooling for recertification purposes.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
