A motion was made by Mr. Shumaker, seconded by Mr. Thornton, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$28,202.73. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the November 2, 2015 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Safety Committee members reviewed a request from Mrs. Rachele Sybert, 329 South Sandusky Avenue, concerning the traffic light at the intersection of East Crawford Street and South Sandusky Avenue. Mrs. Sybert requested consideration for the light to be placed on a normal cycle again, instead of flashing, due to vehicles speeding in the area and children attempting to cross the street at this intersection. Safety Committee members requested the Police Department monitor this area.

Chief Yeater reported that three new volunteer firemen were sworn in this evening at the City Council meeting. Chief Yeater also noted that Mr. Scott Young and Mr. Bob Orr were appointed as Lieutenants and Mr. Keith Johnson was promoted from Lieutenant to Captain.

Chief Yeater also reported that the Fire Department will be holding their annual food drive on Saturday.

Chief Olds reported that the Police Department is providing traffic detail for the Winter Fantasy of Lights event being held in Harrison Smith Park.

A motion was made by Mr. Shumaker, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to enter into an executive session to discuss hiring personnel. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried. Upon completion of the executive session, the Safety Committee reconvened into regular session.

A motion was made by Mr. Shumaker, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to make a conditional offer of full-time employment as a Police Officer to Mr. Nick Temple, pending his passing psychological and physical examinations; and in the future should one of the two full-time officers currently on medical leave not return to employment, their vacancy will not be filled due to attrition. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Shumaker, to recommend to City Council to amend Ordinance No. 215-12 prior to its adoption to set a pay range of \$10.00 to \$13.50 for Police Auxiliary. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried.

There being no further business, the Acting Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
