A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Roberts, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$10,828.39. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Thornton indicated that there were no problems with the annual Backyard BBQ held at Thiel's Wheels on Saturday, August 27, 2016. Mayor Washburn will check with Mr. Allen Boes, Street Department Supervisor, to see if there were any problems with the tent that was placed in the Tarhe Trail cul-de-sac for the event.

Captain Ross presented information of an upcoming change to the Ohio Revised Code, effective January 1, 2017, that prohibits the operation of low-speed vehicles upon any street or highway having an established speed limit greater than thirty-five (35) miles per hour. Captain Ross indicated that this would include golf carts, and particularly golf carts being driven on East Wyandot Avenue within the posted forty-five (45) mph speed limit area extending to the City's east corporation limit. Captain Ross indicated that Chief Olds has discussed this matter with Mr. Mark Ellis, Law Director, and legislation regarding the operation of golf carts within the City should be presented in the near future.

Captain Ross indicated that there are several new upcoming laws in the state of Ohio that will take effect in 2017 including Ohio becoming a one license plate state.

Chief Yeater presented the Safety Committee members and Mayor Washburn with Incident Type Reports from the Fire Department between January 1, 2015 and December 31, 2015 and between January 1, 2016 and August 22, 2016.

Chief Yeater stated that the Fire Department is in the interview process and looking to add two or three new volunteer firemen.

Chief Yeater noted that all trucks and equipment at the Fire Department are currently operating well.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
