A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Shumaker, to schedule Trick-or-Treat to be held on Saturday, October 29, 2016 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Yeater reported that the Fire Department prepared 1,000 chicken halves for their annual Chicken Barbeque held on Monday, July 4, 2016 and the meal was sold out.

Chief Yeater also reported that the Fire Department has responded to a couple of structure fires over the last few weeks.

Chief Yeater further reported that Firemen Scott Young and Bob Orr recently completed Fire Officer I training in Bowling Green and online. Now all three of the Fire Department's full-time firemen have completed this training. Additional training for these firemen is being planned including inspector training.

Chief Yeater indicated that he has been in contact with Love's Travel Stops concerning the possibility of conducting fire training at the former Woody's Restaurant and Pamida buildings.

Captain Ross reported that all is well at the Police Department.

Mayor Washburn stated that the fireworks display held on Saturday, July 2, 2016 at the high school was excellent.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
