A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Roberts, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$23,128.41. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the January 3, 2017 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Roger Hendricks again addressed the Safety Committee concerning the possibility of having an indoor air rifle range on the second floor of the building located at 229 South Eighth Street, as presented at the January 3, 2017 Safety Committee meeting. Mr. Hendricks indicated that he has reviewed sections of the Ohio Revised Code pertaining to air rifles and he has obtained information pertaining to lead management. Mr. Hendricks also visited two ranges since the January 3, 2017 Safety Committee meeting, one in Mt. Vernon and also Camp Perry located near Port Clinton. Mrs. June Larick inquired with Mr. Hendricks as to if either of the ranges he visited were located near residences. Mr. Hendricks responded that the range in Mt. Vernon is located within the City limits. Mr. Roberts suggested Mr. Hendricks poll the members of City Council to determine if they are favorable of changing the City's existing ordinance prohibiting this activity. It was a majority consensus of the members of the Safety Committee to leave the City's existing ordinance pertaining to discharging firearms as is.

Chief Olds presented and reviewed the Upper Sandusky Police Department's 2016 Year End Report with the members of the Safety Committee.

Chief Olds reported that a new repeater was installed on the City's water tower located along Malabar Drive and it has helped a great deal with communication issues that were being experienced.

Chief Olds also reported that the Police Department is beginning the Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system and it will be in place by the end of 2016. Features of CAD will allow reports to be shared with the Sheriff's Department and dispatchers will be able to see where patrol cars are located within the City for faster responses to calls.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
