A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Wessler, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$38,273.34. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the May 1, 2017 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Safety Committee members reviewed the Police Officers and Lieutenants Labor Agreement that has been negotiated, effective retroactively on January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019. Acting Chief Ross inquired as to if the officer in-charge pay would be included in the retroactive provision. Mayor Washburn indicated that all pay for officers and lieutenants would be retroactive to January 1, 2017.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to recommend to City Council to approve the Police Officers and Lieutenants Labor Agreement effective retroactively on January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Thornton presented a request from Thiel's Wheels to hold their annual Backyard Barbeque and set up a tent in the cul-de-sac on Tarhe Trail on Saturday, August 26, 2017. Mr. Thornton indicated that Thiel's Wheels will be responsible for filling the holes created for the tent. Safety Committee members voiced no objections to this request.

Mayor Washburn and Safety Committee members expressed their condolences on the recent passing of former Fire Chief Tom Fox.

Acting Chief Ross reported on the following items:

- Upgraded mobile data terminals have been installed in the police cruisers.
- Printers for e-citation will soon be installed in the police cruisers.
- The Police Department is moving forward on a computer aided dispatch system.
- Guide wires on the antenna located on top of the Safety Building are in need of replacement.
- The new canine unit is currently in training.

It was noted that there was good attendance and good feedback received as a result of the bicycle rodeo held on Saturday, May 20, 2017 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., as discussed at the May 1, 2017 Safety Committee meeting.

Mr. Thornton indicated that there are three applicants within the Police Department who have expressed interest in the Police Chief position. Those individuals are Acting Chief Dan Ross, Officer Allen Foust, and Officer Roger Hetzel. Interviews for the position will be held soon.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
