A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Wessler, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$36,595.46. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the January 2, 2018 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Jon Hawkins addressed the Safety Committee indicating that he feels a stop sign is needed at the driveway exiting Trinity Evangelical Church that is located along the south side of East Wyandot Avenue. It was noted that the City cannot place a stop sign at this location as this is a private driveway. Mayor Washburn indicated that he will reach out to a representative of the church with this suggestion.

Mr. Dave Yeater, Wyandot Classics and Cruisers, addressed the Safety Committee indicating that the car club would like to hold their annual Autumn Cruise in the downtown area on Saturday, September 22, 2018.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Wessler, to approve the annual Autumn Cruise to be held in the downtown area on Saturday, September 22, 2018. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Ross reviewed the Police Department's 2017 Year End Report with the members of the Safety Committee.

Mr. Roberts stated that there was a misunderstanding with the request that was reviewed by the Safety Committee at the December 4, 2017 Safety Committee meeting from Mr. Morris Lear, Custom Glass Solutions, 12688 SH 67 South, pertaining to the placement of a sign to be located in the City right-of-way prior to the driveway of the shipping/receiving entrance to help identify the entrance to semi-trucks. Mr. Roberts indicated that Custom Glass Solutions was not asking for permission to put the sign up themselves, they were asking for the City to put a sign up for this purpose. Mr. Wessler inquired as to if two signs should be placed in this area for this purpose, one on each side of the roadway. Mr. Roberts noted that only one sign should be needed.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Thornton, for the City to order and erect a sign to be located within the City right-of-way indicating the shipping and receiving entrance for Custom Glass Solutions. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Ross requested permission to list the Police Department's 2012 Dodge Charger for sale on govdeals.com.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to authorize the listing of the Police Department's 2012 Dodge Charger for sale on govdeals.com. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Yeater reported that the Fire Department's new aerial is now in service, and the old aerial truck will be listed for sale soon on govdeals.com.

Chief Yeater also noted that in March there will be an Insurance Service Office (ISO) survey to evaluate the City's fire rating.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
