A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Wessler, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$16,909.66. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the February 5, 2018 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

It was again noted that the mutual aid fire protection contracts with Crane, Mifflin, and Salem Townships expire on July 1, 2018. Chief Yeater indicated that he plans to attend meetings of each of the townships to discuss the contracts. Safety Committee members requested a summary of fire calls with these townships from Chief Yeater.

Mr. Roberts indicated that Custom Glass Solutions has expressed their appreciation to the City for the placement of a sign located prior to the driveway of the shipping/receiving entrance to help identify the entrance to semi-trucks, as approved by the Safety Committee at the February 5, 2018 Safety Committee meeting.

Captain Gillig reported that one of the Police Department's Dodge Charger cruiser sold recently on govdeals.com for \$6,825.00.

Captain Yeater reported that the Fire Department's old aerial truck is currently listed for sale on govdeals.com.

Safety Committee members reviewed a notice from the Ohio Division of Liquor Control for the transfer of a liquor permit from Thorntons Inc (dba Thorntons 71), 10134 Princeton Glendale Road, West Chester Township, Cincinnati, Ohio 45246 to Loves Travel Shops & Country Stores Inc., 1301 North Warpole Street, Upper Sandusky, Ohio 43351. Safety Committee members voice no objections to this transfer.

Captain Gillig also reported that the Police Department's new SUV police cruisers have been ordered.

Chief Yeater also reported that he met today with a representative from the Insurance Service Office (ISO) and an inspection of the Fire Department's records was conducted. Chief Yeater indicated that some suggestions were given but the visit went well overall. A final report is expected in four to five months.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
