A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Latham, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$49,355.46. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the December 6, 2010 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Veith suggested the Service Committee consider increasing the pay rate of two sanitation employees to bring their hourly rate of pay to be equivalent to that of the other sanitation employees. This matter will be further discussed at an upcoming Service Committee meeting.

Mr. Dave Westbrook, Water Treatment Plant Supervisor, reported that the cold weather is slowing down progress on the construction of the new water plant.

Mr. Allen Boes, Street and Sanitation Supervisor, reported that the cost for a new street sweeper is \$208,425.00; the cost for a temporary repair of the back tank on the City's existing street sweeper/vac all is \$16,565.00; the cost to install a new vacator body unit and other accessories on the City's existing street sweeper/vac all is \$151,735.00; and the cost to repair the City's existing street sweeper/vac all using the existing body, motor, and electrical is \$64,550.00. Service Committee members tabled further discussion of this issue until a determination is made on the availability of funding in the City budget. Mr. Boes was also asked to obtain a quote on the cost of purchasing a street sweeper/vac all combination and an amount for the trade in of the City's existing street sweeper/vac all.

Mr. Boes also noted that he is currently looking into new recycling trailers and he will be checking into a 50/50 match grant for this possible purchase.

Mr. Boes also reported that Bender Communications recently worked on the City's radios. It was noted that the City's high band radios will be obsolete in 2013.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
