A motion was made by Mr. Chad Smith, seconded by Mr. Dale Rowe, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$110,662.29. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) funding for the painting of the elevated water tower located on Indian Mill Drive. It was noted that this funding would be a 0% interest loan for a total amount of \$500,000 for a 30 year period. A motion was made by Mr. Hank Latham, seconded by Mr. Dale Rowe, to recommend to City Council to enter into an agreement with OPWC for this project as stated above. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mayor Washburn reported on a meeting with ODOT representatives regarding paving options and other available programs. Mayor Washburn extended his appreciation to the ODOT representatives.

Mayor Washburn reported on a request from Mr. Bob Nachbar for relief on a \$7.90 water bill for a rental property located at 404 West Walker Street. The Service Committee determined that Mr. Nachbar would be responsible for payment of this bill.

Discussion was held concerning the condition of the roadway and driveway area in the vicinity of JR Equipment on Wendy's Way. Mr. Allen Boes, Street Department Supervisor, will look at this area.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
