A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Latham, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$87,541.81. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the June 2, 2014 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Shumaker indicated that he would have the representative selling bags for Wastewater Treatment Plant sludge beds contact Mr. Putnam. It was noted that this system is currently being utilized in Hebron, Ohio. Mr. Putnam indicated that he would also like to see a belt press process for treating sludge.

Mayor Washburn reported on a complaint received from Mr. Gary Johnson of damage to the right front tire of his vehicle caused by a pot hole in the alley behind the old Certified Gas Station. Mr. Johnson would like the City to pay for the damages. Service Committee members agreed to check the area and the City's policy in these situations. Ms. Alissa Paolella, Daily Chief Union, indicated that as part of her research for an article she wrote recently she learned that municipalities have no liability in these situations.

Mayor Washburn reported that Mr. John Searfoss, Water Distribution Supervisor; Mr. Allen Boes, Street and Sanitation Supervisor; Mr. Scott Musgrave, Water Treatment Plant employee; and Mr. Dave Westbrook, Zoning Inspector; attended a preconstruction meeting last week at the Ohio Department of Transportation office in Lima for the Marseilles Avenue/Eighth Street Improvement Project.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Rowe, to enter into an executive session to discuss employee discipline. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried. Upon completion of the executive session, the Service Committee reconvened into regular session.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
