A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Rowe, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$32,697.72. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the May 19, 2014 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Roberts inquired as to if residents, who had landscaping done in their yards recently as part of the Northeast Quadrant Waterline Improvements Project, are able to water the newly landscaped areas. It was noted that residents can water these areas at their discretion.

Mr. Swinehart indicated that he has received complaints from residents asking why the American Flags were not hung in the downtown area for Memorial Day. Mr. Boes noted that the flags will be hung before July 4.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Rowe, to enter into an executive session to discuss employee pay raises. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried. Upon completion of the executive session, the Service Committee reconvened into regular session.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Rowe, to authorize 25¢ step pay increases for Mr. Jim Shull for completing six months of employment and for Mr. Nate Bash and Mr. Pat Stansbery for both completing three months of employment. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mayor Washburn indicated that he received a complaint from a resident concerning open burning within the City. It was noted that the City follows the regulations contained in the Ohio Revised Code concerning fires being permitted for cooking and recreational purposes. Service Committee members noted that if materials other than wood are being burned the Police Department should be contacted.

Mr. Putnam reported that the Ohio EPA recently reassigned their Inspectors and Mary Beth Cohen is now the City's Ohio EPA Inspector.

Mr. Putnam also reported that a sludge press is currently being demonstrated at the Waste Water Treatment Plant.

Mr. Aaron Schoenberger reported that he has obtained his Class III license and Mr. Dave Heimrick has obtained his Class I license.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Latham, to authorize the appropriate pay increases for Mr. Aaron Schoenberger for obtaining a Class III license and for Mr. Dave Heimrick for obtaining a Class I license. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Boes inquired as to if new safety yellow t-shirts can be ordered for the three new employees. Service Committee members voiced no objections to this request.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
