A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Rowe, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$28,043.33. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the October 20, 2014 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Ms. Karg indicated that headlights from motorists' vehicles are causing the street light located at the southeast corner of Tarhe Trail and State Route 53 to shut off. The Mayor's office will contact American Electric Power concerning this matter.

It was noted that Mr. Nick Wentling has completed six months of employment with the City and is eligible for a step raise.

A motion was made by Mr. Latham, seconded by Mr. Rowe, to approve a 25¢ step pay increase for Mr. Nick Wentling. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that Mr. Rob Shoaf, URS engineer, has completed a demonstration study on the new membranes installed at the Water Treatment Plant. Mr. Schoenberger compiled the necessary data and forwarded it to Mr. Shoaf for submission to the Ohio EPA to verify that the same quality and quantity of water can be produced.

Mr. Searfoss reported that construction under the Eighth Street repaving and waterline replacement project, done in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation, has been completed. The roadway painting and some yard work needs to be finished.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
