Discussion was held regarding the Broadview Street Extension Project. It was noted that one bid was received from Underground Utilities Inc., 416 W. Monroe Street, Monroeville, Ohio for a total cost of \$557, 128.20 for this project.

A motion was made by Mr. Don Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Dale Rowe, to recommend to City Council to accept the bid from Underground Utilities Inc., 416 W. Discussion was held concerning trapping at the reservoir for the winter season. The Service Committee authorized the Mayor to advertise for trapping rights for the 2014-2015 seasons for the reservoir. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

At this time, the committee discussed a step raise for Service Department employee, Mr. Nick Wentling. It was noted that Mr. Wentling is eligible for a twenty five (.25) cent step raise. A motion was made by Mr. Hank Latham, seconded by Mr. Dale Rowe, to approve a twenty five (.25) cent step raise for Mr. Nick Wentling. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning the purchase of rock salt for use on the city streets for the 2014-2015 winter seasons. It was noted that a conference call with ODOT to discuss options for this season.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
