TOTAL BILLS: \$119,689.04

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Rowe, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$119,689.04. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the June 15, 2015 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Matt Newell, 203 Canyon Drive, addressed the Service Committee and expressed concerns about the sewer overflows due to recent heavy rains. Mr. Newell indicated that he has had issues with sewer backup in his home due to the rains. Service Committee members explained upcoming projects to alleviate sewer issues and future legislation that would prohibit residents' sump pumps and downspouts from being tied into the sanitary sewer.

Service Committee members inquired with Mr. Boes as to the status of a bucket truck to replace the City's existing bucket truck. Mr. Boes indicated that he has been unable to find a bucket truck within the City's \$25,000.00 budget that is certified, as required by the City's insurance agent. Service Committee members requested Mayor Washburn talk to the City's insurance agent about the possibility of certifying the City's existing bucket truck if the engine can be repaired.

Mr. Boes reported that the City's street sweeper is back in service.

It was noted that the Safety Committee, during their meeting held prior to this meeting, approve yellow diagonal lines to be painted on the roadway adjacent to the Union Elementary/USMS parking lot along West Finley Street. Mr. Boes was asked to contact Mr. Mark McQuown, Upper Sandusky Schools, to obtain more information on where these lines should be painted.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that Morral Excavating will be performing excavation work at the Water Treatment Plant next week. The estimated cost for this work is \$5,000.00.

Mr. Boes also reported that more street grinding will be taking place soon.

A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Rowe, to enter into an executive session to discuss a personnel matter. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried. Upon completion of the executive session, the Service Committee reconvened into regular session.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
