A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Latham, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$530,757.09. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the June 6, 2016 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

The Refuse Contract with the Wyandot County Fair Board for the Wyandot County Fair was discussed. It was decided to table this matter until the next Service Committee meeting in order to obtain additional information.

Mr. Putnam reported that the preconstruction meeting for the Sewer Separation Project will be held on Friday, June 24, 2016 beginning at 10:30 a.m. at the Municipal Building. Construction under this project is expected to begin in late July or early August.

Mr. Putnam also reported that Mr. Mark Ellis, Law Director, continues to work on the engineering agreement between the City and AECOM for the proposed Water Reclamation Facility Project.

Mr. Putnam further reported that Buckeye Pump representatives completed the work to upgrade the pump station in Harrison Smith Park in approximately six to seven hours. Mr. Putnam noted that he would like to see the Orchard Drive lift station upgrade done in late fall 2016 or early spring 2017.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that monitoring equipment has been placed at the reservoir and testing of water from the reservoir and finished water is being conducted to monitor conditions for potential algae blooms.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
