A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Voorheis, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$238,870.51. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the May 7, 2018 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Taylor reported that the City resident living at 400 Raybestos Drive has requested a street light in their area. Service Committee members will look at the area prior to making a decision on this request.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that he was contacted by Mr. Jeff Dible concerning a disc golf tournament to be held in mid July and requested permission to camp at the reservoir the night before the tournament. Service Committee members requested Mr. Schoenberger gather more information since the City was not notified of the event.

Mr. Schoenberger also reported that the new air compressor for the Water Treatment Plant should be delivered in early June and Harris Electric will be doing the necessary wiring for the compressor.

Mr. Taylor indicated that Ms. Linda Stansbery, Administrative Assistant, is attempting to schedule a meeting to include Mr. Taylor, Mr. Mark Ellis, Law Director, and Mr. Dave Westbrook, Zoning Inspector, to go over requirements for dumpster bullpens.

Mayor Washburn presented site plans for a new addition and change to the driveway at Bringman-Clark Funeral Home, 226 East Wyandot Avenue. The proposed addition to the front (south) would extend over the existing driveway located in front of the building, which exits onto North Fifth Street; so the request is being made to allow the proposed driveway, located at the west side of the property, to exit onto East Wyandot Avenue. Service Committee members requested that the Police Chief be consulted to determine if there are any issues with this request.

Mr. Thornton reported that paving on West Bigelow Street, as part of the West Water System Improvement Project, was completed today.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
