A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$337,815.80. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the December 3, 2018 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Nick Derr, Wyandot County Fair Board, addressed the Service Committee and requested relief from a portion of the Wyandot County Fair Board's sewer bill due to a recent water line break that resulted in a high bill. The water line break occurred in the pit that is located north of the block restroom building, across the driveway to the northwest of the arena building. Mr. Derr indicated that water from this leak ran into a tile. Service Committee members indicated that they will need to verify that the water from the leak went into a drainage tile and not into a sewer tile. Mr. Dave Schneider, Collections System Supervisor, will be asked to run the City's camera into this tile to determine where this tile leads. Mr. Derr will be contacted upon Mr. Schneider's findings.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
