A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Wessler, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$15,240.25. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the December 3, 2018 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Chief Ross recommended the hiring of Mr. Charles Seeley as a Police Officer. It was noted that the necessary testing, including examination, psychological, and physical, has been completed along with a job interview.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Wessler, to hire Mr. Charles Seeley as a Police Officer, effective January 13, 2019. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

An inquiry was made with Chief Ross regarding the results of the traffic flow pattern established for the Winter Fantasy of Lights. Chief Ross noted that complaints were received from individuals regarding the length of time they had to be in line, which was an unavoidable circumstance. Chief Ross indicated that the traffic pattern met the objective of less congestion and improved traffic flow. Chief Ross credited Captain Seth Gillig for the improvements to the traffic flow. Chief Ross also stated that assistance was received from other City departments in directing traffic.

Appointments to the Volunteer Fire Fighters' Dependents Fund Board for 2019 were discussed.

Mr. Wessler nominated Mr. Roberts and Mr. Thornton as appointments by the legislative authority to the Volunteer Firefighters' Dependents Fund Board for 2019. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
