

CITY COUNCIL

May 20, 2019

The May 20, 2019 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Don Spiegel, Bill Thornton, John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, and Marc Mays. Rick Roberts was absent.

Others present included: Mark Ellis, Law Director; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the May 6, 2019 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the May 6, 2019 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the May 6, 2019 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the May 6, 2019 Planning Commission meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the May 13, 2019 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Mays, to place Ordinance No. 55-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 48-13, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 55-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Walker, seconded by Mr. Thornton, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 55-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 55-13 was duly adopted.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Korte, to place Ordinance No. 56-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CITY OWNED REAL ESTATE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 56-13 for the first time by title only.

It was decided that the members of City Council will tour the new Water Reclamation Facility that is currently under construction beginning at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, June 17, 2019, prior to their regularly scheduled meeting.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
