

CITY COUNCIL

June 3, 2019

The June 3, 2019 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Don Spiegel, Bill Thornton, John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Marc Mays, and Rick Roberts. Aaron Korte was absent.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the May 20, 2019 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the May 20, 2019 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Mays, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to place Ordinance No. 56-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CITY OWNED REAL ESTATE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted as follows:
