

CITY COUNCIL

July 1, 2019

The July 1, 2019 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, Marc Mays, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, and Bill Thornton. Aaron Korte was absent.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Bentley Mays; Brody Mays; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the June 17, 2019 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the June 17, 2019 Tree Commission meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the June 17, 2019 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the June 21, 2019 special Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

It was noted that the annual Budget Hearing will be held prior to the July 15, 2019 City Council meeting beginning at 7:15 p.m.

Mr. Spiegel invited City Council members to tour the Water Reclamation Facility project site on Monday, July 15, 2019 beginning at 6:00 p.m. The previous tour scheduled was cancelled due to excessive rainfall.

Mayor Washburn noted that the annual fireworks display will take place at the high school on Friday, July 5, 2019 with Sunday, July 7, 2019 being the raindate for this event. Motorists were reminded to use caution when leaving the fireworks due to the high volume of people expected to be in the area.

Mayor Washburn also noted that Wyanstock will be held at the fairgrounds on Friday, July 5, 2019 and Saturday, July 6, 2019.

Mr. Ellis noted that the Fire Department's annual Chicken Barbeque will be held on Thursday, July 4, 2019, with tickets currently on sale at a cost of \$9.00 each, and meals available for pick up at the fire station from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Washburn reminded City Council members that the sale date for a portion of Waterworks Park has been set to be held on Thursday, July 25, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. on the park premises. The night for interested individuals to view the land has been set for Monday, July 15, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
