A motion was made by Mr. Spiegel, seconded by Mr. Voorheis, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$245,128.19. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the June 17, 2019 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mr. Putnam provided an update on the construction of the new Water Reclamation Facility noting that the footers for the administration building are done and the headworks is in progress. Mr. Putnam indicated that due partially to the heavy rainfalls experienced this year, the construction completion date for this project has been extended to December 2020, and the EPA has approved this extension.

It was decided that a tour of the Water Reclamation Facility project site for the members of the Service Committee and City Council will be held on Monday, July 15, 2019 beginning at 6:00 p.m. The previous tour scheduled was cancelled due to excessive rainfall.

Mr. Taylor reported that street and alley resurfacing within the City has started.

Mr. Taylor also reported that sanitation customers who normally have their trash picked up on Thursdays, will have their trash picked up on Friday, July 5, 2019 this week due to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday.

A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, to enter into an executive session to discuss an employee matter. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. Upon completion of the executive session, the Service Committee reconvened into regular session.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
