Chief Ross reported that Chelsi Newman, who was hired by the Safety Committee at the June 21, 2019 special Safety Committee meeting as a full-time police dispatcher, started work today.

Chief MaGinn reported that tickets are still being sold for the Fire Department's annual Chicken Barbeque to be held on Thursday, July 4, 2019 with pick up being from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the fire station.

Chief MaGinn also reported that the fireworks will be held on Friday, July 5, 2019 at the high school at dusk and the required State permits for this event have been obtained.

Chief MaGinn further reported that an inspection was done recently of the Fire Department's ladder truck, and an inspection of all of the ladders on the truck is scheduled for October.

Chief MaGinn noted that several applications have been received for volunteer fire fighters. Chief MaGinn indicated that it has been decided that due to past applicants receiving the necessary training paid by the City and then leaving the fire department, that all future volunteers will begin in July and assist for six months before going to training in January.

Chief Ross reported that the "No Parking Here to Corner" signs located along North Eighth Street near the intersection of West Bigelow Street have been placed at the proper setback from the intersection.

Chief Ross also reported that the Police Department's fiber optic phone lines will be installed next month.

Chief Ross further reported that the police dispatchers have been trained on the updated 911 system, which is more user friendly than the previous system, and the updated system will be up and running soon.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
