

## CITY COUNCIL

August 19, 2019

The August 19, 2019 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Marc Mays, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, Bill Thornton, John Walker, Kenneth Wessler, and Aaron Korte.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Mark Droll, City Auditor; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the August 5, 2019 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the August 5, 2019 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the August 5, 2019 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the August 12, 2019 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, to place Ordinance No. 60-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE NO. 48-13, TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF UPPER SANDUSKY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 60-13 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Korte, seconded by Mr. Walker, to place Resolution No. 61-13 entitled, "A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Resolution No. 61-13 for the first time by title only.

Mr. Spiegel reported that he inquired with Mr. Dave Westbrook, Zoning Inspector, as to the status of Casey's General Store and Mr. Westbrook indicated that the status of this development is currently unknown. Mayor Washburn indicated that this project is currently out for bid.

Mr. Wessler reported that he attended activities over this weekend for the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Shawshank Redemption movie and on behalf of the Mayor he presented four Keys to the City to individuals involved with the movie.

It was agreed that the next City Council meeting will be moved to Tuesday, September 3, 2019 due to the Labor Day holiday on Monday, September 2, 2019.

It was reported that on Saturday, August 17, 2019 there was a military convoy that traveled through Upper Sandusky as part of a transcontinental trip along the Lincoln Highway. The convoy stopped for lunch at the Upper Sandusky High School.

It was also reported that this Saturday, August 24, 2019 the first ever Battle of the Badges charity softball game, featuring the Upper Sandusky public safety forces (police and fire department personnel) vs. the Carey public safety forces (police and fire department personnel), will be held in Harrison Smith Park beginning with a homerun derby at 12:00 p.m. and game beginning at 1:00 p.m. Proceeds benefit the Wyandot Memorial Hospital Oncology Services.

Mr. Droll reviewed the Recapitulation for July 2019 with the members of City Council.

A letter of resignation was received from Mrs. Shelley Beidelschies as a member of the Civil Service Commission as she will be moving out of state. It was noted that this vacancy is an appointment by City Council.

There being no further business, the President declared the meeting adjourned.
