The minutes of the July 8, 2019 Park Board meeting, having been mailed to each Park Board member, were approved as received.

It was reported that the pool rumba sweeper was ordered for the swimming pool and is being used.

Mr. Niederkohr thanked the Wyandot Classics and Cruisers for their donation of \$736.06 made to the Parks Department from the car show they held in Harrison Smith Park on Saturday, July 20, 2019.

Mr. Niederkohr thanked the summer help employees who worked for the Parks Department this summer, and he noted that this is their last week of work.

Mr. Niederkohr reported that he currently plans to close the splash pad in Bicentennial Park after Labor Day weekend. The splash pad could remain open if the weather is hot.

It was noted that the swimming pool in Harrison Smith Park will be open thru Sunday, August 18, 2019 and then be open on weekends thru Labor Day.

It was reported that a portion of the land located in Waterworks Park sold at auction for \$100,000.00. Mr. Niederkohr indicated that he plans to move the restroom located on this land to the park land at the top of the hill next year. A concrete slab will need to be poured and electric, water, and sewer hookups will be need to be installed at the new location.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
