

CITY COUNCIL

November 4, 2019

The November 4, 2019 City Council meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Don Spiegel, President. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. City Council members present were Kenneth Wessler, Aaron Korte, Marc Mays, Rick Roberts, Don Spiegel, Bill Thornton, and John Walker.

Others present included: Scott Washburn, Mayor; Mark Ellis, Law Director; Ben Buckland, Attorney; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the October 21, 2019 City Council meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were approved as received.

The minutes of the October 21, 2019 Tree Commission meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

The minutes of the October 21, 2019 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each City Council member, were reviewed.

A motion was made by Mr. Thornton, seconded by Mr. Roberts, to place Ordinance No. 63-13 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A LABOR AGREEMENT WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIREFIGHTERS, LOCAL 4523, FOR THE PERIOD ENDING OCTOBER 31, 2022, COVERING FIREFIGHTERS FOR THE CITY, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SUCH AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AND DECLARING THIS ACT AN EMERGENCY.", on its first reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 63-13 for the first time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Roberts, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to suspend the rules of the Municipal Charter calling for separate readings on different days. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Korte, seconded by Mr. Mays, to place Ordinance No. 63-13 on its second reading by title only. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes; the President declared the motion carried. The Clerk read Ordinance No. 63-13 for the second time by title only.

A motion was made by Mr. Walker, seconded by Mr. Spiegel, for the adoption of Ordinance No. 63-13. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The President declared the motion carried and Ordinance No. 63-13 was duly adopted.

Mr. Spiegel noted that a tour of the new Water Reclamation Facility will be held for Service Committee and City Council members on Monday, November 18, 2019 beginning at 4:30 p.m.

Mayor Washburn indicated that representatives from the City will be ringing the Salvation Army bell at Walmart on Friday, December 6, 2019 for those City Council members interested in volunteering.

Mayor Washburn stated that there are still two tickets available to the annual Wyandot County Economic Development dinner will be held at The Vault in Carey, Ohio on Wednesday, November 6, 2019 from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. if any City Council members are interested in attending.
