

PLANNING COMMISSION

December 2, 2019

The December 2, 2019 Planning Commission meeting was called to order at 6:45 p.m. in Council Chambers by Marc Mays, Acting Chairman. Planning Commission members present were Marc Mays, Sara Lou Binau, Nancy Johnson, and Jordan Treadway. Scott Washburn was absent.

Others present included: Dave Westbrook, Zoning Inspector; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The minutes of the November 4, 2019 Planning Commission meeting, having been mailed to each Planning Commission member, were approved as received.

Planning Commission members reviewed a petition received by the Clerk on November 13, 2019 for the detachment of 28.672 acres of land from the City of Upper Sandusky as signed by owners Steven C. Rall and Drew A. Rall. It was noted that this land was formerly a portion of the City's Waterworks Park that was sold during the summer of 2019.

A motion was made by Mrs. Treadway, seconded by Mrs. Johnson, to recommend to City Council to approve the detachment of 28.672 acres of land from the City of Upper Sandusky as presented. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Acting Chairman declared the motion carried.

Planning Commission members received copies of sample legislation from other communities addressing farm animals located within the city limits. Planning Commission members were asked to review the information received for future discussion of this matter.

It was noted that the new Dollar Tree store located at 1120 East Wyandot Avenue opened recently.

It was also noted that containers were recently placed on the property of the proposed site of Casey's General Store, 301 West Wyandot Avenue, and demolition of the existing buildings is expected to begin soon.

There being no further business, the Acting Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
