A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Roberts, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$25,085.38. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the November 4, 2019 Safety Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Safety Committee member, were approved as received.

Chief Ross and the Safety Committee again discussed the request for additional handicap parking spaces on the west side of Sandusky Avenue as presented at the October 7, 2019 Safety Committee meeting. Chief Ross suggested the parking space in front of First Federal Bank, 118 South Sandusky Avenue, and adjacent to the alley located to the north be designated as handicap; and the first parking space on the north side of East of Chicago Pizza, 200 South Sandusky Avenue, along the south side of West Johnson Street and adjacent and west of South Sandusky Avenue, also be designated as a handicap parking space.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Thornton, to designate the parking space in front of First Federal Bank and the parking space on the south side of West Johnson Street as handicap as suggested by Chief Ross. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Chief Ross reported that the directional signs for the Winter Fantasy of Lights (WFOL) are in place and the City labor departments will be assisting with directing traffic again this year.

Mr. Thornton expressed his appreciation for serving on the Safety Committee and indicated that he enjoyed working with this committee. Safety Committee members and Mayor Washburn thanked Mr. Thornton for serving on the Safety Committee. Chief Ross thanked Mr. Thornton for his support of the Police Department.

Chief Ross urged caution as there will be extra pedestrian and vehicular traffic in the City on Saturday as the annual Home for the Holidays festivities will be happening.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
